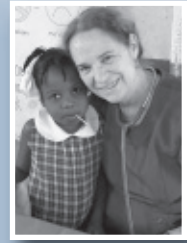

Dr. Jane Lochrie began her medical career as a staff nurse at Mass General and advanced to the ranks of Pediatric Nurse Practitioner. She earned her Medical Degree from UMass Medical School, and completed her residency at St. Vincent Hospital. Dr. Lochrie practiced as a General Internist for the Fallon Clinic/Reliant Medical Group from 1986-2017. In addition, she held many teaching positions including Program Director for the Internal Medicine Residency Program at St. Vincent Hospital.



Dr. Lochrie served as the President for WDMS from 2008-2010. In addition to participating in and chairing many committees, she is the Chief Editor for Worcester Medicine. Dr. Lochrie is the recipient of multiple honors and awards, including the 2018 Leonard Tow Humanism in Medicine Award. She was the cofounder of the Women's Health Clinic for then Fallon Clinic, and is the Medical Director for the St. Anne's Free Clinic in Shrewsbury where she volunteers weekly.

In an effort to maintain her passion and fulfill her personal goals of serving the underprivileged, Dr. Lochrie has participated in mission trips to Haiti, where she continues to help educate and care for those in great need.

ABOUT THE ORATION

Haiti, with its uniquely tragic history, is one of the poorest countries in the world. Natural disasters, poverty, racial discord and political instability has plagued this small country. Today Haiti is a nation in disarray, unsafe, economically desperate without much clear hope of improvement for the near future. In order to understand Haiti today you have to know the history.
