Narcan (or Naloxone) is an opioid antagonist that is used for the complete or partial reversal of an opioid overdose. It is safe, easy to administer, has no potential for abuse, and can save the life of someone who is experiencing an opioid overdose.

AIDS Project Worcester (APW) provides free training in the use of nasal Narcan both at our facility and at training events. By receiving our Narcan training, you will be prepared if someone experiences an opioid overdose.
